

## FERNAND PETIOT, THE FATHER OF THE BLOODY MARY

In 1934, Fernand Petiot, bartender at The St. Regis New York's legendary King Cole Bar, perfected the recipe for an unusual vodka and tomato juice cocktail he called the Bloody Mary, which has become a beloved libation for over 75 years.

Since the name Bloody Mary was deemed inappropriate for the hotel's elegant clientele, it was rechristened the Red Snapper. While the name may not have stood the test of time, Fernand's spicy concoction certainly has, and the Bloody Mary remains the signature cocktail of St. Regis Hotels & Resorts, with each hotel crafting its own interpretation of the original. Tequila adds a touch of the desert in Texas; whiskey brings the highlands to London. Whatever the location, Bloody Mary rituals can enliven a group breakfast, reinvigorate an afternoon meeting break or kick off a celebratory dinner.

Today, The St. Regis Aspen Resort pays homage to Mr. Petiot with the Downhill Snapper, our interpretation of his classic concoction.
